Many rare animals and birds are found in these lands according to their natural habitat. Of Nepal's total land, 23% is covered by nine National parks, six conservation areas, three wildlife areas, and one hunting reserve.

Tour Bardiya National Park, one of Nepal's largest wildlife reserves, covers **an area of 968 km. It is in the far southwest corner of open Nepal, bounded by middle hills in the north and the** Karnali River to the west and south.

From 1976 to 1988, Bardiya Reserve expanded from 368 sq. km to 968 sq. km. Later, in 1988, it was designated a National Park. Compared to other national parks, Sagarmatha National Park, Annapurna Conservation, Langtang National Park, Se Phokosundo National Park, and Chitwan National Park, it is a more significant national park.

Bardiya National Park Tour provides an excellent habitat for more than 40 mammal species, 150 reptiles and fish, and over 400 birds. The Bardiya National Park is full of rhinos, wild elephants, a royal Bengal tiger, swamp deer, gharial crocodile, marsh mugger, crocodile, Gangetic dolphins, blackbuck, leopard, lesser cats, the blue bull(nilgai), the langur, sloth bear, and the wild bear.

Beautiful and colorful birds can be seen on the banks of one of the largest rivers, the Karnali River. Endangered birds like Bengal Florian, Lesser Florian, Silver-eared Mesia, and Sarus Crane. [Bardiya National Park](#) trip includes elephant rides, jeep drives, canoe rides, Jungle walks where possible, and bird-watching tours.

You can visit all year, but the best time is from October to April, as the roads and rivers become impassable during the monsoon. A Bardiya National Park tour offers plenty to explore and many species.
