Phase 1: Flight From Kathmandu to Lukla

The helicopter tour to Everest Base Camp was initiated from the airstrip in the capital city of Nepal, Kathmandu. The flight heads eastbound, hovering over hamlets and rural settlements that scatter along the hilly region of the country.

Phase 2: Land at Lukla Airport, Refuelling, then Fly again

Lukla Airport was chosen to refuel the aircraft since the fuel carried is low enough for a faster transfer. Tenzing Hillary Airport, or Lukla Airport, is Everest's busiest airport and town, catering to trekkers and local needs. After taking off from Lukla, the aircraft enters Sagarmatha National Park.

Once refueled, your chopper will fly over the narrow alleys above Dudhkoshi River, following the trekking trail to Everest Base Camp. You will observe various small Sherpa settlements scattered sparsely beneath your flight route.

Phase 3: Temporary Halt at Pheriche, Shuttle overfly trip

Your Helicopter will first land in Pheriche to drop off extra weight. From the five passengers boarded in the Heli, two passengers will be dropped off at Pheriche, and the remaining three will be taken off to overfly Base Camp and Glacier.

Phase 4: Flight of the 2nd lot of Passengers to Base Camp and Return.

The remaining two passengers at Pheriche will take a roundtrip journey to EBC in the same chopper. It is guaranteed that all the passengers will have a window seat during the trip.

Since flying over Everest Base Camp with passengers on board is not feasible, you will have panoramic views of the Everest vista from the Helicopter. As the Helicopter takes the roundtrip, you will again land at Pheriche to pick up the remaining three passengers and go to Everest View Hotel for breakfast.

Phase 5: Syangboche stopover, Everest View Hotel Breakfast

From Pheriche, your heli will take you to Syangboche, an unpaved airstrip above Namche bazaar. You will then head to Everest View Hotel, one of the most famous landmarks of the Everest region. After breakfast with the panoramic views of Everest Vista, you will board your Helicopter again for your return journey.

Phase 6: Stopover at Lukla, Continue towards Kathmandu

From Syangboche, your heli will take off and head southbound towards Lukla. After refueling at the airstrip, you will continue your return by Helicopter to Kathmandu Airport.

Note: This trip is an aerial trip on a helicopter substantially affected by the weather conditions during your travel time. If unforeseen events occur, your journey will be postponed for the following day.

Best seasons for the Helicopter Tour in Everest Region

Nepal has several different seasons. Please have a look at the other seasons for more information.

Spring Season

Springtime is the optimum weather for an Everest Base Camp Helicopter tour. Handling the Helicopter will be easy because the sky is clear and there is excellent visibility.

This excursion will be spectacular throughout March through May when temperatures range from +15 to -5 degrees Celsius. It will rain, but the moderate temperature and clear atmosphere will always be prevalent during spring.

Autumn Season

An Everest Base Camp Helicopter tour is one of the best things to do from September to November. This expedition will benefit significantly from the weather. It is ideal for an Everest Base Camp helicopter tour due to the temperature range of +10 to +20 degrees Celsius and clear skies free of clouds and fog. The climate can change according to the traveling months.

Summer Season

As spring is monsoon season, heavy rainfall in the lower areas is below 3000m. We are also arranging Everest Base camp helicopter tours during the summer season. Due to global warming, more than 3000m higher in Everest region doesn't face rainfall. Similarly, due to less rainfall in the higher areas, many travelers take a helicopter tour in the summer. But, for your safety purposes, we'll check the weather forecast before starting the tour.

The temperature will be around +20 to +25 degrees Celsius. However, amid clear weather, the magnificence of the Everest region will not fail to surprise you even during the summer season.

Winter Season

The Everest area will see shallow temperatures from November to February. During the winter season, the Everest Base Camp helicopter tour is challenging due to the western wind generating severe fog and snow, reducing visibility to virtually nil.

Therefore, carrying out this tour on a sunny, warm day is only conceivable. However, the weather in the Everest Region may change quickly.

During this season, the Everest Base Camp Helicopter tour is challenging because the freezing

temperatures range from -6 to -25 degrees Celsius. However, we are still operating during this time.

Mount Everest tour from Kathmandu by Helicopter

The Helicopter Tour to Everest begins from the bustling city of Kathmandu and flies over several small villages along the way. Before landing in the Everest region, your flight flies across several Himalayan districts, Dolakha, Ramechhap, and Okhaldhunga.

The Nepalese Himalayan belt extends from far east to west in Nepalese territory, acting as a border to Tibet to the north. Apart from all these, there are several enigmatic views that you will savor on the Kathmandu Everest Base Camp helicopter tour. The Everest Heli experience is unmatched by other Heli trips in Nepal.

Why Should We Have Multiple Landing for Everest Mountain Flight?

We have multiple landings for the Everest Mountains flight for a few reasons. In the first stage, we take off from Kathmandu's airport and land at Lukla to fuel the Helicopter. Second, we landed at Pheriche at 4200m due to the high elevation and for the shuttle, as the government of Nepal doesn't allow people to carry a 450 kg load over 5000m. So this is why we have to make two flights from Pheriche and land there. Thirdly, you'll land at Kalapatthar to enjoy the stunning scenery.

Another reason to land at breakfast after your tour is that you have breakfast at an elevation of 3800m at Syangboche. Along with enjoying the view and having breakfast, you'll land at Syangboche for 20 minutes. After breakfast, you'll take off and land at Lukla again to refuel the Helicopter.

Altogether, you have five different landings for Everest Mountain flight for other purposes.

How safe is Everest Base Camp Helicopter Tour with us?

We see the weather forecast before the helicopter flight. If the weather is terrible, we postpone the flight to the following day. We don't want our clients to face problems due to weather conditions, so we check the weather forecast before the Helicopter takes off.

Pre-briefing of the flight helps travelers respond to the different situations at the Kathmandu airport. We have a cylinder of oxygen in our Helicopter. Also, We have a headset to stay connected and tell each other what we feel during the tour. The captain will let you know about every mountain range through the headset.

Day 02: Everest Base Camp helicopter tour with landing at Kalapathar

We must wake up early in Kathmandu and drive to the domestic Airport an hour before the flight. We'll inform you about the trip details a day before.

Phase 1: Fly from Kathmandu - Lukla (5/7 minutes landing at Lukla for fueling and take off to Pheriche)

Phase 2: Fly to Pheriche and land for the shuttle

Phase 3: Shuttle to Kalapathar in two flights (for 2 and 3 people).

Phase 4: Take off from Pheriche to Syangbouche

Phase 5: After breakfast, take off from Everest View Hotel to Lukla and fly back to Kathmandu

Time and Activity

5:30 - 6:00 Drive from the hotel to the Airport

A private vehicle will take you to the airport opposite your hotel. Likewise, you will be stepping inside the car with your light bag and warm equipment. You'll drive from the hotel to the Domestic Airport within about 10 /15 minutes if you are not staying overnight at the center point.

6:00 - 6:30 Boarding

There won't be much waiting for you at the Airport. One of our ground handle tour operators will handle the check-in and formalities at the Airport. The stunning helicopter will wait for us to board as we pass through the airport entrance. We will make our way to the plane with incredible optimism and enthusiasm.

6:30 - 7:15 Kathmandu to Lukla Flight

After settling into the rear seat, the helicopter will eventually take off toward the. As we leave the verdant hilly regions, the altitude will gradually increase.

The helicopter overflies Sindhupalchowk, Khotang, Lamjura-Pass, and the Solukhumbu hamlets. After the 30- to 45-minute flight, there will be a touchdown at Lukla Airport.

7:15 - 7:30 Landing and Refueling

As the helicopter refuels and has its fuel capacity inspected, it will take around 5 minutes. Dazzling hamlets sitting on the lap of massive countryside and clouds will completely astonish us.

7:30 - 7:50 Lukla to Pheriche, Landing

The helicopter will take off, carrying us well compared to the Himalayas. The panoramas of Namche Bazaar, Sagarmatha National Park, and the magnificent Rhododendron forest below will be exhilarating.

The scenic view of Mount Thamserku, Tabuche, Amadablam, and Everest to the north will be soothing to savor from the window.

Our helicopter will arrive on the Pheriche after around 15 minutes of flying. The neighboring monasteries will be the significant thing to see while exploring Pheriche.

7:50 - 8:10 landing in Kalapathar on two different flights

Due to the high altitude and unpredictable weather, only two or three individuals will be carried from Pheriche to Kalapathar by helicopter.

Then the helicopter will return to take the remaining passengers to Kalapathar. We are not landing at Kalapathar longer than 5/7 minutes on every flight.

Ariel vistas of Makalu and Mount Everest to the north will also be breathtaking in addition to the mesmerizing Everest perspective. The Kalapathar will be the highest point of the Everest Base Camp Helicopter Tour, having a landing height of almost 5,360 meters and a spectacular view.

8:10 - 8:30 Pheriche to Everest view hotel

The panoramic view of the Khumbu Region from Kalapathar will be intriguing. You also have a stunning view of Mount Makalu, 8481 meters. Mount Lhotse is 8516 meters, Mount Cho Oyu is 8201 meters, Amadablam is 6812 meters, Mt.Lhotse Shar is 8383, and Nuptse is 7861 meters high from sea level.

Similarly, everyone is together at Pheriche after the two flights and landing at the Kalapathar. We take off to the best hotel for a warm breakfast.

We called Everest Viewpoint. We will have a warm breakfast and enjoy the nearest views of Mount Amadablam, Thamserku, and Tabuche Peak, including Mount Everest. We'll take off after your breakfast.

9:15 - 9:30 Fly to Lukla and Refueling

After incredible views from the hotel, we will continue to fly to Lukla airport. The Everest region's astonishing flora will make for one of the most fantastic air travel.

From above, the hamlets that descend to the cliffs appear spectacular. We will land in Lukla briefly until we fully refuel and take off.

9:50 - 12:10 Fly to Kathmandu and drive to the hotel

The helicopter will return to Kathmandu as we take in our final destination of the magnificent Himalayas and the stunning perspective of the Everest region.

We can land at the Domestic TIA airport after flying above waterfalls, valleys, vegetation, and picturesque hamlets from Eastern to Central Nepal.

The incredible Everest Base Camp Helicopter Tour will then end as our representative drives you back to your hotel by private vehicle and has a rest.

Frequently Asked Questions

Do you land at the top of Mount Everest?

We are sorry for not allowing a Helicopter to land at the top of the world. Landing on the top of Mount Everest is strictly prohibited according to Nepal law. We'll land at the Pheriche and over the fly of Kalapathar, Base Camp, and Glacier.

What to expect on Everest base camp helicopter tour?

You will expect the best scenery of Mount Everest, Glaciers, and Landscape, completely fill your ego to see the Everest Base Camp, and have the best breakfast over 3800 meters from the sea level.

Where can we get the national park permits, and what's the cost?

Boundless Adventure also provides Mt. Everest entrance permits in Kathmandu, but you will get them at Lukla or Shyangbouche alone. We suggest you better you will get on your own.

The permit cost depends on nationality. If your race is Indian, it will cost INR 2000/- per person, but the rest of the countries require US\$ 35/- per person or the equivalent of Nepali rupees.

How many people can we travel together by helicopter?

Five people can fly together at once on an Everest base camp Helicopter tour. But, if you would like a charter, you may also travel alone.

From where can we see Mount Everest?

You can see Mount Everest right after you take off from Lukla Airport. Yes, it is a bit far away, but it looks nice.

How long will be the Everest base camp helicopter tour?

The trip will be three to four hours from Kathmandu airport to Everest base camp, have breakfast at the five-star hotel, and Fly to Lukla and Kathmandu.

What are the chances to see Mount Everest?

There is a 100% chance to see Mount Everest please note that we are not flying while weather conditions are not guaranteed.

How can we pay for the trip?

You can pay by any card on your arrival or in cash, but we need some advance while you are going to book the trip. Just confirm your trip. Please, inform us by email about it.

Does a Nepali bank charge while we are using any cards?

Yes, every bank charges you some percentage of the amount while withdrawing from an ATM and using a Visa card, Master Card, or American Express.

What about ground transportation?

We are providing ground transportation on request, according to the size of your group. We do have a car, Jeep, Van, and bus.

What happens if we can't fly due to weather?

If you can't fly on time due to the weather, we will try to fly on the following days at the exact cost. You don't have to pay extra for helicopters, but you must pay for ground transportation. However, you will get a refund if you don't have time even in the next few days.

Is it safe to ride a helicopter to Everest Base Camp?

Yes, there is no doubt about safety. It is safe to travel to Everest by helicopter. We have been operating such tours from Kathmandu since 1992.

The Everest Heli tour is Expansive?

Well, It is not too expensive to go on the Everest tour by Heli. But it is more luxurious to travel around

because you don't have to walk around.

Are Helicopter tours cold?

Yes, We need to have enough warm clothes even though you are not hiking. It won't be cold while you are flying, but it will be cold while you land at Pheriche and have breakfast at 3800 meters. You should have warm equipment with you. If you are still confused, please let us know, and we'll advise you on the trip and types of equipment.

When is the best time to get a chopper tour to Everest?

Four seasons are the best time for a chopper tour to Everest tour. Monsoon is the heavy rainy season and the weather is not clear every day.

From Kathmandu domestic heliport, we take off to Lukla and Everest base Camp. But, sometimes, the weather can change unpredictably. In case of bad weather, we are unable to fulfill our promise. In such a case, we are not going to take off from the

Kathmandu airport. The tour will be postponed for the following day.

Everest Base Camp Helicopter Tour from Kathmandu to Lukla

Early in the morning, the helicopter departs from the Tribhuvan domestic airport in Kathmandu and goes to Lukla. The helicopter tour from Kathmandu to Lukla is a nonstopable flight. The Helicopter flies over the valleys of Nagarkot, Hun Beshi/ Nun Thala, and Namjura. The 45-minute flight takes you to Lukla. As you land at Lukla, the Helicopter stops for fueling for about 6-7 minutes.

Everest Base Camp Helicopter Tour at Kalapathar Landing

The **Everest Base Camp helicopter tour at Kalapathar landing** is only possible for the private charter flight with a group of 3 or fewer people. After refueling, the Helicopter took off from Lukla and landed at Kalapathar. After the Helicopter lands at Kalapathar, you'll explore the surrounding area. Consequently, the Helicopter flew over Everest base Camp and Khumbu Glacier. After that, the Helicopter returned to Syangboche.

Helicopter from Pheriche to Kalapathar Landing

The Helicopter flies from Lukla and then lands in Pheriche. The Helicopter must land at Pheriche on the shared helicopter tour. The Helicopter takes five people at once, but from Pheriche, it can take all the people to Kalapathar. The shuttle must land at Pheriche. On the first shuttle from Pheriche, the Helicopter got three people and went for landing at Kalapathar.

As you can see from the vantage point of Kalapathar, the helicopter flew over Everest base camp and Khumbu glacier and returned to Pheriche. Again, the Helicopter flies over the same airway as the second shuttle. After the shuttle, everyone gets the window seat to enjoy the view completely.

Helicopter from Syangboche to Kalapathar and Everest Base Camp

Helicopter flight from Syangboche to Kalapathar and Everest Base Camp is another service Boundless Adventure provides. You may already be at the Syangboche from Lukla by trekking. After you spend the overnight at Syangboche, we'll pick you up from your hotel and then go for a helicopter tour to Kalapathara and Everest Base Camp. But the option is only possible for less than three or just three people.

Helicopter flight to Gokyo Lake

Although there is no direct helicopter flight to Gokyo from Kathmandu, if you fly to Syangboche or are already at Syangboche, we can manage the flight to Gokyo. From Syangboche, it takes 20 minutes to get to Gokyo. As you get closer to Gokyo Lake, we'll overfly Gokyo Lakes and land by Gokyo Lake. As you land at Gokyo Lake, you'll explore the area, enjoy the view of the lake, and return to Syangboche.

Everest Base Camp helicopter tour to Lukla/ Kathmandu

After fueling, we'll fly to Kalapathar and explore the surrounding areas. After exploring Kalapathar, you'll fly over Everest Base Camp and Khumbu Glacier and return to Lukla without stopping for breakfast. You can have breakfast back to Lukla. After breakfast and refueling the Helicopter, you'll return to Kathmandu.

The Weather at the Everest Base Camp changes throughout the year. Around the year, the region faces distinctive weather with four seasons. Spring, the most popular season for Everest helicopter tours, faces temperatures tentatively +15°C to -5 °C around the Everest region. The weather during the Spring (March to May) is stable, with clear skies, making it suitable for helicopter tours. The blooming of the rhododendron makes the surroundings vibrant with its color.

The Summer season begins after the Spring season. Summer(June to August) is the hottest season of the year in Nepal; however, it is also the monsoon season. The Temperature ranges from +20 ° C to +25 ° C in the Everest region during summer.

Autumn occurs after the Summer and monsoon seasons in Nepal. Autumn falls in the middle of September and ends in November. With temperatures ranging from +10° C to 20 ° C, the weather remained stable and chilled in autumn, with beautiful landscapes. With a clear sky, the visibility of the surrounding peaks is excellent. Winter is the coldest season, from the end of November to March, with temperatures ranging from -6 ° C to -25 ° C. The views of the mountains during the winter are excellent. However, weather conditions are harsh with extreme cold. Due to freezing weather conditions, snowfall occurs in the Everest region, making it difficult to enjoy your tour fully.
