Gosainkunda Helicopter Tour Highlight

- The Gosainkunda helicopter tour is an adventure and pilgrimage tour starting from Kathmandu.
- Superb views of the Langtang Himalayan region and Gosainkunda Lake

Trip Overview

Gosaikunda Helicopter Tour is north of Kathmandu and central to [Langtang National Park](#) Nepal, which is close to the Tibetan border.

The historically “large rock in the center of the lake” is said to be the remains of the Shiva shrine. We believe that Lord Shiva had once meditated here in the Hindu legend.

Nine other lakes are near the Gosaindunkunda: Bhairab Kunda, Saraswati Kunda, Dud Kunda, Rani Kunda,

Raja Kunda, Nau Kunda, Batash Kunda, Surya Kunda, Ama Kunda, Ekle Kunda, Tinchuli Kunda, and Ganesh Kunda.

However, it is an hour's Gosainkunda helicopter tour from Kathmandu. We provide you with the cost, itinerary, and price details for 2024 and 2025. You can contact us anytime on **Whatsapp at +977 9851033819 or by email now.**

The Gosainkunda Helicopter tour offers an astonishing landscape view around the 4360 m-high Lake of Gosainkunda. The Lake's water is assumed to go directly to the pond at the Kumbeshwar Temple in Patan Durbar Square.

The Gosainkunda Heli tour package goes above the Langtang Himalayan range. The Himalayas are rich and offer views of the [Manaslu Himalayan Range](#), Ganesh Himal, Shisapangma, and the beautiful cliff landscape.

A great fair is held here in the Janai Purnima (One of the ritual celebrations) every year in August and bathes on Gosainkunda Lake. Boundless Adventure organizes the panoramic tour of Gosainkunda Lake.

Alternative ways to go to Gosainkunda Lake

Gosainkunda Lake is 4380 meters from sea level; Gosainkunda Lake is famous for Hindu pilgrimage. However, you can't get by driving; you must choose a few options.

If you need more time and are a senior citizen, you may go by Helicopter from Kathmandu airport. It takes 20 to 30 minutes to get to Gosainkunda and, at the same time, to get back into Kathmandu, but we will give 30 to 45 minutes for ground landing time.

If you have enough time, you may start to 4w or bus drive from Kathmandu, Dhunche, overnight at the Dhunche, start hiking via [Sing gumba](#), Cholangparty Lauribinayak, and get into the Gosainkunda Lake.

You can take a bath in the Lake and pray in the Temple. Similarly, some people are starting to hike from Sundarijal.

Note: *There are too many different Lakes around the Gosainkinda. But you need to hike about 300 meters to Gosainkunda. You can have a great chance to see the best views of the other side and the Himalayas range, including some higher and deeper Lakes.*

Trip Itinerary

Gosainkunda Helicopter Tour starts from the domestic airport of Kathmandu, Nepal. It is just 1-hour round trip from Kathmandu, but we will land by the Lake for another half an hour at 4380 meters.

Even though you are a solo traveler during the main traveling seasons, you can share the tickets with others, but a maximum of 5 people can travel together in one shuttle.

Similarly, if you are a group of 7/8 people, you must charter two helicopters or share with another group in a different helicopter.

Similarly, March to June and September to December are the best times to travel by helicopter to Gosaikunda Temple and Holy Lake. The Langtang Himalayan range has beautiful scenery and several different holy Lakes. Please check out the itinerary and cost details and Contact us for trekking in 2024 and 2025.

Day 01: Kathmandu -Gosainkund -Kathmandu.

Phase 1-

Take off from Kathmandu Airport to Gosainkunda Lake, 15 minutes.

Phase 2-

Explore the Gosainkunda for 30 minutes.

Phase 3-

Fly back to Kathmandu airport for another 15 minutes.

Total 1 hour Minutes around the trip.

Where is the Gosaikunda

Gosaindkunda is an alpine freshwater holy lake in the Rasuwa district of Nepal. The lakes lie at 4,380 m/ 14,370 ft within the Langtang National Park and are a religious site for Hindus. Hindu mythology considers Gosaikunda to be the residence of the Hindu gods Shiva and Gauri.

When is the best season for Gosaindkunda tour?

The best season starts from March to June and September to December, but the main festival falls in August.

How much does it cost to go to Gosainkunda by helicopter?

The cost of going to Gosainkunda by helicopter varies depending on your group size. Boundless Adventure provides a group discount; thus, the larger the group, the more we offer a discount. The cost ranges from \$260 to \$1300 per pax.

How long does it takes Gosaikunda Helicopter tour?

The Gosaikunda Helicopter tour takes 15 minutes to get to Gosaikunda from Kathmandu you will have a ground landing time of another 30 minutes and return to Kathmandu in another 15 minutes.

How many people can travel together in a helicopter?

A maximum of five people can travel together in a helicopter. Thus, we provide two helicopters for groups with more than five people for the Gosaikunda tour.

Are we able to get a shared helicopter to Gosainkunda?

A shared helicopter to Gosainkunda is not possible. We provide shared helicopter options in well-known destinations, including Everest Base Camp and Annapurna Base Camp. However, we cannot offer you a shared helicopter for the Gosainkunda helicopter because it is less famous. Nevertheless, we operate

charted flights even for a single person.

How far is Gosainkunda from Kathmandu by helicopter?

Gosaikunda is just 25 minutes away from Kathmandu by helicopter. From Tribhuvan International Airport of Kathmandu, travelers land near the Gosaikunda Lake within 25 minutes.

Is Gosainkunda Lake frozen?

Yes, Gosainkunda Lake is frozen during winter and is popularly known as a frozen lake. Not only is Gosainkunda Lake frozen, but there are more than 108 other lakes in the surrounding area, all of which are frozen during winter. However, the lake is normal during the rest of the year.

How safe is it to go to Gosainkunda by Helicopter?

Going to Gosainkunda by helicopter is indeed safe. Boundless Adventure ensures your safety by providing the latest helicopter model and a skilled pilot.

Where can we land a helicopter in Gosainkunda?

On your helicopter tour, you'll land near Gosainkunda Lake. You'll have a ground landing for about 30 minutes. During those 30 minutes, you'll visit Gosainkunda Lake and participate in religious activities.

Why is Gosainkundda Famous?

One primary reason for Gosainkunda's fame is its religious significance to Hindus. According to Hindu myth, the lake was the residence of Lord Shiva. Another reason is its beauty; majestic mountain peaks surround the lake, creating a stunning area's beauty.

Do we need Permits to go on the Gosainkunda helicopter tour?

One plus point of a Gosainkunda helicopter tour is that Permits are not necessary. However, two permits are mandatory for trekking, including a Trekkers Information Management System (TIMS) card and a Langtang National Park permit.

Is there a Shiva temple in Gosainkunda?

Yes, Lord Shiva's temple is in Gosainkunda, known as Gosainkunda Temple. The temple lies near Gosainkunda Lake. Travelers on the Gosainkunda Lake tour will also visit Shiva's temple and engage in religious practices.

Can we take a bath at Gosainkunda Lake?

Yes, everyone can take a bath in Gosaikunda Lake. Also, Hindus believe bathing in the lake of Gosainkunda will wash away all sins, provide positivity to one's body, and bring blessings from Lord Shiva.

How long we can land at Gosaikunda ?

We can land at the Gosaikunda in 30 minutes. It will depend on the weather conditions. Sometimes, the weather can change emidetly.

Best seasons for the Gosainkunda Helicopter Tour

Gosainkunda Lake is lye in the Langtang National Park of Nepal. The altitude of Gosaindlunda is 4380 meters above sea level. The best season starts from March to June and September to December.

Gosaikunda Helicopter Tour cost

Gosaikunda is listed at 4380 meters high altitude from sea level. A lot of Hindu pilgrims travel to Gosaindkunda by Helicopter and on foot. Similarly, a Helicopter tour costs US\$ 260/- per person, including ground transportation during the primary season. We suggest you have a group of five people or multiply by five.
