## Pokhara Sightseeing Day Tour

Pokhara sightseeing day provides you with an enhancing experience of the city's most iconic areas and beauty. The sightseeing day on Pokhara begins with the drive to Sarangkot early in the morning for the stunning sunrise view. After the beautiful sunrise sightseeing, you'll head towards David's fall. The Davids waterfall (Patale Chhango) lies 2 km southwest of Pokhara. David's Fall is an astounding waterfall that develops a 500-foot-long underground tunnel when it reaches the bottom. The fall is the major attraction and tourist area of Pokhara, which provides the stunning beauty of the waterfall.

After sightseeing at Davis Falls, you'll move towards World Peace Pagoda, known as Shanti Stupa. The

World Peace Pagoda lies on the hill of Anadu and adds to the overall beauty of Pokhara. The stupa at the hilltop provides a stunning view of the Mountain ranges, Phewa Lake, and the entire Pokhara Valley. The stupa is also famous for providing mesmerizing views of sunrise and sunset.

Mountaineering Museum is another tourist area of Pokhara where more than 100,000 tourists, including domestic and international visitors, visit. After sightseeing at the World Peace Pagoda, you'll visit the International Mountaineering Museum. The museum has three main exhibition halls where you can see. The halls include the Hall of Great Himalayas, the Hall of Fame, and the Hall of World Mountains.

After a beautiful sightseeing day, you'll return to your hotel location, which will be near Phewa Lake. In the evening, you'll have a boating experience at Phewa Lake. There are two other lakes also: Begnas and Rupa).

From an elevation of 1600m, you can see the dazzling majesty of nature at Sarangkot.

Sarangkot is the finest location in Pokhara for photographers and nature lovers to capture the extraordinary beauty of sunrise and please their eyes. Paragliding options are also available at Sarangkot. Travelers can experience the beauty of Pokhara through the sky with a bird's eye by paragliding from Sarangkot.

## **Chitwan Jungle Safari and Wildlife Adventure**

Welcome to the city of temples and antique cultural monuments.

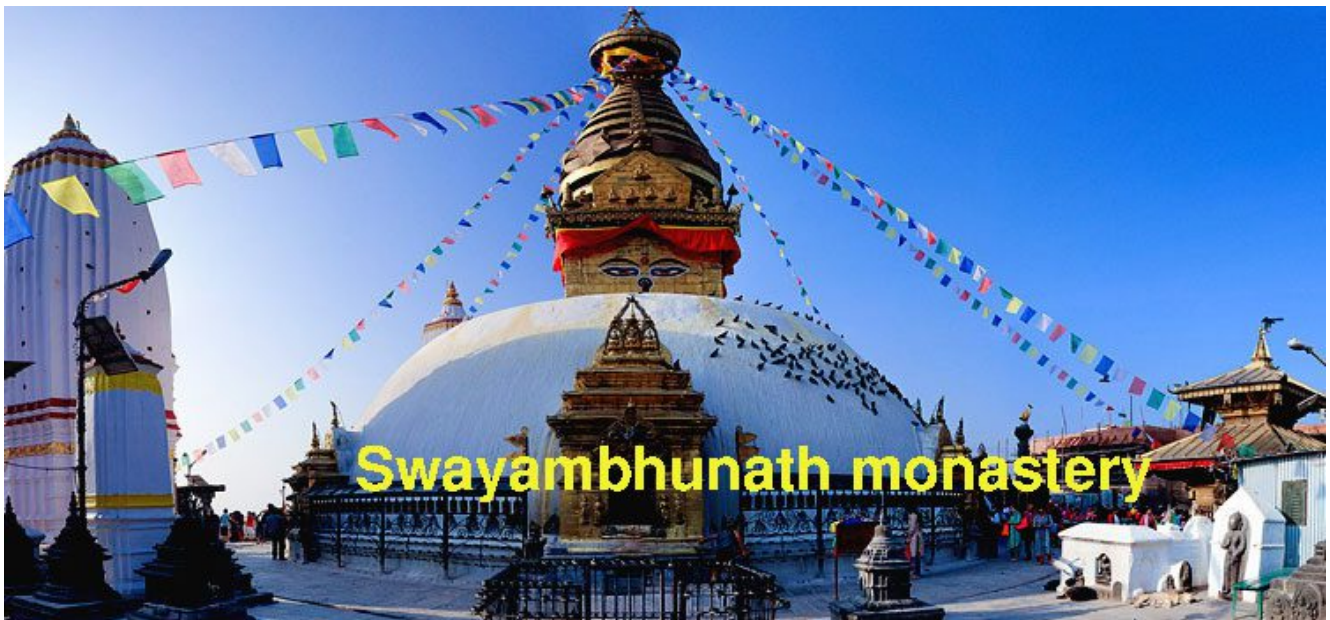

Having breakfast at the serene lakeside, pack the luggage and drive to Chitwan.

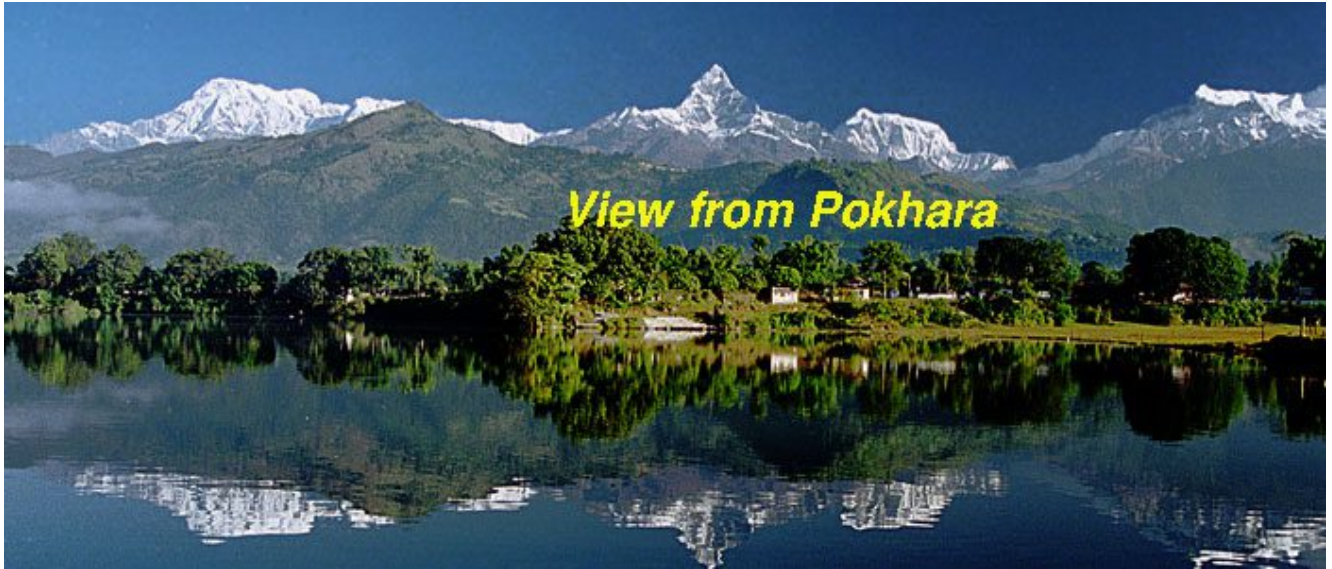
It's a fantastic drive that has a less bending route. Half of the way is towards Kathmandu. Then, it was directed toward the lowland region of Nepal.

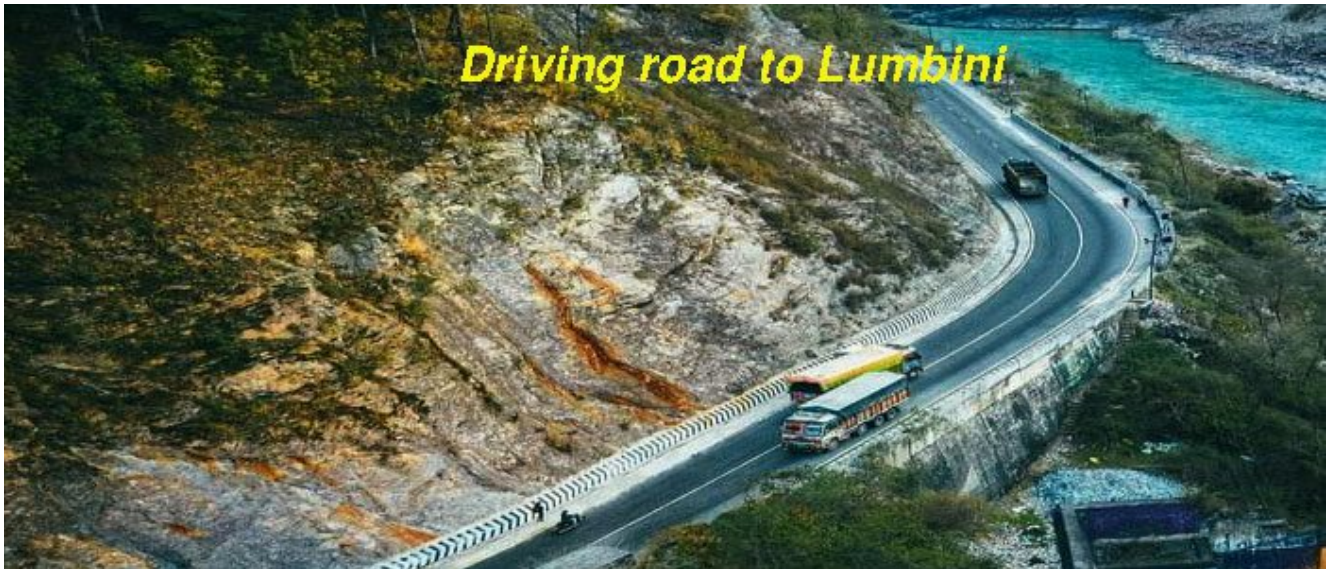

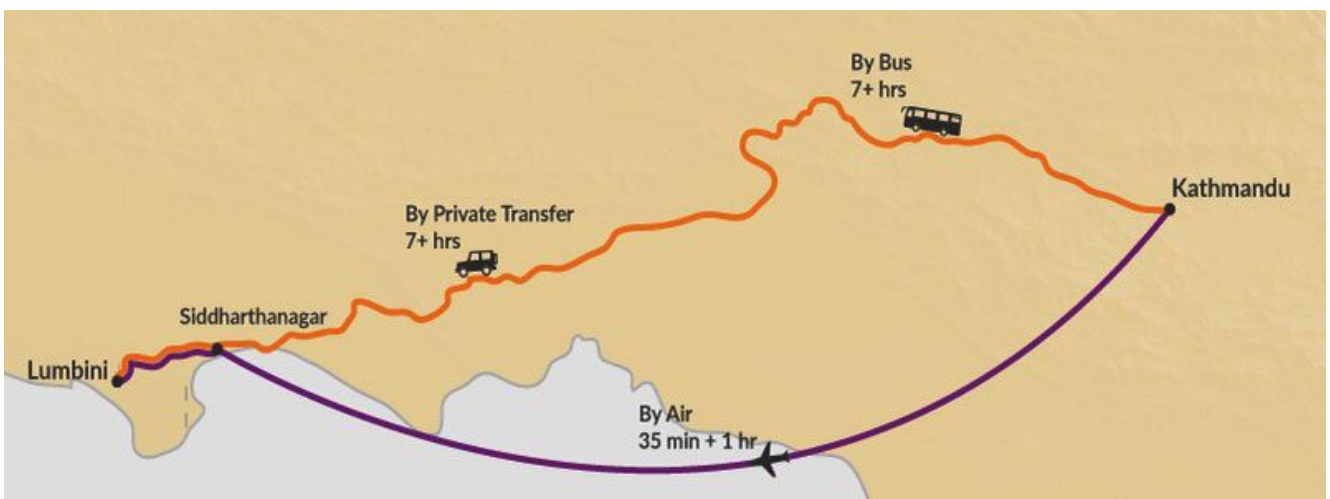

Stick dance is widely famous and performed by the Tharu cultural groups.

Lumbini is the birthplace of Lord Buddha, who was born about 2500 years ago, a pioneer who spread the message of peace and prosperity, Lord Buddha.

In Lumbini, you can explore the diverse scenery of several ancient temples, including the Mayadevi temple, Puskarini pond, Pillar of Ashoka, monasteries of various countries, a beautiful garden, and many sights around give enough space to make your day incredibly spectacular.
