Trip Overview

Muktinath helicopter tour is flying around the central Annapurna conservation region of Nepal. A maximum of 5 people can ride at once from Kathmandu and Pokhara. The Muktinath is the holy place for Hindus, Jain, and Buddhist religions. Thousands of people visit it every year.

The Temple has three different statuses: 1) Bishnu, 2) Garuda 3) Laxmi. Muktinath is located at 3800m above sea level in the Mustang district. The Muktinath temple lies on the route of the Annapurna Circuit trekking area. The helicopter tour lets you visit Jwala Mai Temple, Gomba Samba, and Swaminarayan.

There are two different landing grounds in front of Muktinath Temple. One is for VIPs, the other for the public. Most of the time, we land at the nearest Muktinath Temple. Sometimes, we need to land 2 km away.

People Can easily walk into the Muktinath Temple. Some people ride horses and yaks to get to the entrance gate of Muktidham Temple from the Helipad. Regarding the Horses and yaks, you need to contact them in advance and pay them on the spot.

Similarly, some people from Kathmandu are doing the Muktinath Temple tour by Jeep. But, it is only during the dry seasons. We can't drive a Jeep during the Monsoon season to Muktinath tour.

The Temple of Muktinath is the trip package's main attraction and destination. (Nearby Temple) It has a Miracle-burning lamp on the stream, believed to be created by the Lord Brahma (god of creation in Hindu mythology).

The water pond on the front of the Temple regarded as is the pond for purifying the body and the soul, along with the bath on 108 Muktidhara (Running water taps).

The whole area is the salvation place where Budevotee' Sonks and Hindu date. **Muktinath Helicopter tour** itineraries can vary according to the duration of your trip.

The scenic Muktinath helicopter tour, which starts in Pokhara and is famous, offers panoramic views of the Manaslu, Nilgiri, Dhaulagiri, and Annapurna Himalayan ranges, as well as deep gorges and stunning landscapes. The tour is renowned for its worship and holy baths. Boundless Adventure has often led it.

About Muktinath Temple

At an elevation of 3800m (12467m) on the bottom of the highest pass of Nepal, Thorong la Pass, Muktinath is the most prominent and holiest site to Hindus and Buddhists. In Mustang district, the temple has gained fame for its location at the highest elevation.

The Muktinath temple is the only one where travelers can see the harmony between the two religions. The temple is dedicated to Lord Vishnu, and there is a giant statue of Buddha, which one can find nowhere, proving Nepal's status as a secular country.

The Muktinath temple is called Chumig Gyatsa, meaning 'Hundred Waters' in Tibetan. The Muktinath temple is famous among pilgrims who seek blessings and want to attain Salvation and tourists for those seeking blessings and peacefulness.

Surrounded by mountains and the soothing waters of the Kali Gandaki River, Muktinath provides a breathtaking environment for spiritual reflection. Nearby attractions of the temple include the Jwala Mai Temple and stunning views from Thorong La Pass.

Visiting Muktinath offers religious practice and immersion in the region's untouched beauty. The 108 sprouts water of the temple holds great significance because Hindus believe that bathing there washed away all the sins people did in their lives. Furthermore, travelers can explore nearby villages, interact with locals, and taste traditional Nepali cuisine.

The Cost of Tour to Muktinath

The Muktinath Temple is located in the Throng La village development community in Lower Mustang, Dhaulagiri district of Nepal. A round trip from Kathmandu to Kathmandu takes four hours.

Choosing between the Muktinath Tour by vehicle and the helicopter tour is subjective and depends on one's preference. Each tour provides a unique and thrilling experience; whichever package you choose, enjoy it and return happily with thousands of good memories. Here are some differences between the Muktinath Tour by vehicle and Helicopter.

By Vehicle

The Muktinath tour involves getting to Muktinath through ground transportation. Visitors have the option of going by bus or jeep. If you wish to go by bus, you must drive to Pokhara from Kathmandu and then to Jomsom. From Jomsom, you need to take a [Jeep to Muktinath temple](#). If you take a jeep, you'll get to Muktinath Temple from Kathmandu and Pokhara. But, it is too long for senior citizens to travel.

Along the way to Muktinath, travelers can immerse themselves in the locals and their culture while spending time with them.

The tour to Muktinath is suitable for those who want a more immersive experience, want to get involved in local culture, and have time. Accommodation and meals are budgets, frankly. But it takes four days to complete from Kathmandu.

By Helicopter

A helicopter takes visitors directly to the nearest Helipad in Muktinath. One can take a helicopter tour from Kathmandu or Pokhara; both include quick flights.

It provides a quicker and more convenient way to reach Muktinath, which is suitable for travelers with limited time or those who prefer more comfortable transportation.

A helicopter tour to Muktinath provides aerial views of the Himalayan range, providing a unique landscape perspective through a bird's gaze. It is a luxurious service that comes at a higher cost but is best for senior citizens. One can complete the heli tour to Muktinath within 5 hours.

Kathmandu to Muktinath by Helicopter

We'll pick you up from your hotel early in the morning and drop you at Tribhuvan domestic airport for your helicopter flight. We'll pick you up at around 7 am because of unpredictable conditions and climate during the route. Flying with a bird's gaze view of mesmerizing snow-capped peaks, green landscapes, rivers, and green hills, you'll leave Kathmandu.

Flying over the beautiful city of Pokhara, Ghorepani village, Jomsom, and Kagbeni with the view of Upper Mustang, you'll land at the nearest Helipad of Muktinath. However, landing on the nearest Helipad is subject to availability. If the Helipad is complete, you'll land at a helipad a little far from where visitors must walk for 2km to reach Muktinath temple.

The Kathmandu to Muktinath helicopter tour takes an overall 4 hours. The tour is divided into three Phases: the first is to fly to Muktinath from Kathmandu, which generally takes 1 and a half hours. The second phase involves exploring the Muktinath temple and nearby areas for 2 hours. The final phase consists of flying back to Kathmandu using the same air route and with the same aerial view of the area.

Trip Itinerary

Muktinath Helicopter starts from two different places: Kathmandu and Pokhara. Here is the itinerary for both areas.

We provide five-sitter helicopters from Kathmandu and Pokhara. You should contact us in advance for the Muktinath trip.

Day 01: Travel to Muktinath by Helicopter

Muktinath Helicopter Tour Itinerary from Kathmandu

We fly early in the morning from Kathmandu to the Muktinath temple.

You will have 2 hours of ground time.

It is necessary to walk to the temple 2 KM.

After exploring, the Muktinath Temple flies back to Kathmandu.

Muktinath Helicopter Tour Itinerary from Pokhara

It will take 45 minutes to Get into the Muktinath helipad.

You will have 2 hours of ground landing time.

It would help if you walked 2 km one way.

Fly back to Pokhara for another 45 minutes.

Frequently Asked Questions

Where is Shree Muktinath Temple located?

The Shree Muktinath temple is geographically located at between Mount Annapurna and Mount Dhaulagiri in Mustang district of Nepal. However (Here is Google Map **RV8C+QP Muktinath**) the altitude of Shree Muktinath is nearly 2800 meters from sea level.

Where is Shree Muktinath Temple listed?

Shree Muktinath Temple is located in the west part of the Annapurna conservation area of Nepal. It is 27 kilometers away from Jomsom Airport and the bottom of the Throung La Pass, which is very famous for the Annapurna circuit trek in the Nepal Himalayas.

Where do we land by helicopter?

There are three different helipads for landing near Muktinath. While one helipad is near the Muktinath temple and takes just 5 minutes, another two are a little far, requiring a 1-2km walk.

Can we land the nearest helipad in Muktinath?

We can't guarantee you will land at the nearest helipad in Muktinath, but we'll try our best. Due to the proximity to Muktinath temple, everyone wants to land near the helipad, so there will be less space, especially during peak season. If possible, we'll indeed make you land at the nearest helipad. If not, we believe that you won't mind trekking 2km.

What is the distance from Kathmandu to Muktinath?

The distance from Kathmandu to Muktinath by ground transportation is approximately 371 km (230 miles), involving a drive from Kathmandu to Pokhara, then Pokhara to Jomsom, and then to Muktinath. The distance from Kathmandu to Muktinath by airway is shorter, taking 150 km (93 miles) with a direct flight from Kathmandu airport to the nearest helipad of Muktinath.

What is the cost of a Helicopter tour to Muktinath?

The cost of a helicopter tour to Muktinath varies depending on the season, availability, group size, and any additional services used.

Furthermore, charter flights and shared flights also vary your overall cost. If you prefer taking the helicopter flight alone, it costs more than taking a flight through a group.

How many people can we travel together in a helicopter?

Five people can travel together in a helicopter. But if there are more than five people in a group, let us know we can arrange two helicopters on your behalf. Although your whole team won't be on your helicopter tour, you'll meet your team at the helipad landing area and visit the Muktinath temple area together.

What's the model of the helicopter?

Yes, we operate a B350 airbus for the Muktinath helicopter tour. It is the newest helicopter in Nepal. We operate the same airbus for the Everest helicopter tour, Langtang, Annapurna, and other parts of the helicopter flight sector of Nepal.

Can we share a helicopter to go to Muktinath from Kathmandu?

You can share a helicopter to visit Muktinath from Kathmandu if you are comfortable—even a shared

helicopter costs less, minimizing your overall cost for the tour. However, the availability of the shared helicopter varies based on the demand and season. Thus, we recommend you pre-book to ensure your seat.

When is the best time to travel to Muktinath?

As one can travel to Muktinath temple throughout the year, the best time to travel is a matter of travelers' preference. However, most travelers desire Autumn and Spring due to the pleasant and stable weather conditions. Also, summer is becoming popular for Muktinath tours as it presents sunny and long day hours, providing a more enjoyable visit. Travelers who love experiencing snowfall also travel to Muktinath during winter.

Do we need permits to travel to Muktinath?

Yes, the Annapurna conservation area permit and Trekkers Information Management System (TIMS) card are mandatory for traveling to Muktinath. As the Muktinath temple lies within the Annapurna conservation area, ACAP is necessary, and TIMS is compulsory for traveling to each destination of Nepal. Obtaining those permits is essential to avoid any inconvenience or issues during travel.

How long will there be ground holding time in Muktinath?

You'll have 2 hours of ground holding time in the Muktinath. You can utilize the time to visit all of Muktinath's premises. Also, you can visit the monasteries near Muktinath. You can also visit the nearest village of Muktinath and get involved with the area's locals. Furthermore, you can see the unspoiled beauty of the region.

Can we travel to Muktinath by helicopter from Pokhara?

Yes, you can travel to Muktinath by helicopter from Pokhara. Pokhara is the starting point for Muktinath and the popular destination of the Annapurna region. How long does it take from Pokhara to Muktinath?

One can choose various options to get Muktinath from Pokhara, including ground transportation and airways. If you select ground transportation, you'll drive through a Jeep, which will take 8-9 hours. For the airway, you can choose either an airplane or a helicopter.

If you prefer an aircraft, you'll fly to Jomsom from Pokhara and then take a jeep to reach Muktinath, which takes around 4 hours, including flight and jeep drive. Furthermore, helicopters are the fastest and easiest mode, as you reach Muktinath within 45 minutes from Pokhara.

How much does it cost to travel from Pokhara to Muktinath by helicopter?

What is the Oxygen Level in Muktinath?

Muktinath is at an altitude of 3800m, which is relatively higher. At this altitude, the oxygen level in the air is lower. The oxygen level in Muktinath temple is 70 to 80 percent of sea level. Your blood oxygenation would be around 80 to 90% at such oxygen levels in the air.

Thus, we advise you to visit Muktinath from 10 am to 4 pm to avoid breathing problems. Moreover, travelers should be aware of the potential risks related to altitude sickness. Also, we recommend you consult with a medicine specialist if you have any problem in your body.

Is there an Airport near Muktinath temple?

Yes, there is only one airport near Muktinath Temple, Jomsom Airport, which is 26 km away. After landing at the airport, travelers can reach Muktinath either by trekking or Jeep drive. Going by Jeep drive takes 2-3 hours, but if you prefer hiking, you need to have an overnight stay on the day you land at Jomsom and reach Muktinath another day.

What are the views along the Helicopter to Muktinath?

The views along the helicopter tour to Muktinath are breathtaking, providing a unique view of Nepal's landscape. As the helicopter takes off, travelers see the Langtang and Ganesh Himal mountain ranges. As the helicopter gets near Pokhara and takes direction towards Muktinath, you'll see stunning panoramic views of the Annapurna and Dhaulagiri mountain ranges, including Mount Annapurna, Machapuchare (Fishtail), Nilgiri, are mesmerizing. Furthermore, the beauty of the Gandaki River gorge, traditional villages, terraced farmlands, and Annapurna conservation area's bird's-eye view is astonishing on helicopter tours.

Can senior citizens travel to Muktinath by helicopter?

Yes, senior citizens can travel to Muktinath by helicopter. Not only senior citizens, the tour is suitable for children and any physically disabled people. The Muktinath is not at a much higher elevation, travelers don't have to hike longer, and helicopter tours are comfortable.

Thus, traveling to Muktinath by helicopter is safe even for senior citizens. However, senior citizens should consult with their healthcare provider, stay hydrated, and be aware of the symptoms of altitude problems during the tour.

Essential Information

Muktinath Helicopter Tour information.

During the tour, you may have several different flight phases from Pokhara or Kathmandu. Just keep it in your mind following the schedule of the Chopper at the Muktinath tour.

Phase-1

It takes 1:00 hours by helicopter from Kathmandu to Muktinath.

7:00 am Drive from your hotel to the Domestic airport by car/ Van, and Between 8:00 am and 8:30 am, fly to Muktinath from Kathmandu airport. You fly over the countryside and by the Manaslu, Ganesh Himal, and Annapurna Himalayan range to Pokhara. Continue to fly from Pokhara to Jomsom, the world's deepest valley.

Phase-2

We landed at the nearest Helipad of Muktinath Temple, just a 5-minute walk. However, we usually need to land 2 km away from the temple due to the budget helipad.

We will give you 1.5 to 2 hours to explore/worship at Muktinath Temple and Jwalamai Temple if you are a group of 5 people. (Natural miracle burning lamp on the stream) from Helipad to Helipad.

If you are landing 2 Km away from the Muktinath temple, you need to walk about 2 km from the Helipad of Muktinath, and on the other hand, some people are unable to walk they can get a horse or starchier (Doli) on the sport by themself.

Phase-3

It will take 1:00 hour.

The same way flies to Kathmandu through scenic views of the Himalayas and landscape in the Annapurna conservation area of Nepal.
