## Trip Overview

Namu Buddha Tour is another impressive and historically Buddhist pilgrimage site located 40 km southeast of [Kathmandu Valley](#) in the Kavre district. The highlight of the main stupa at the hilltop is the world heritage monuments of UNESCO, where visitors can enjoy the incredible views of mountains and green fields.

Namu Buddha means "Greetings to the Lord Buddha." Buddhist mythology contains an interesting story

According to Buddhist sutras, Lord Buddha was born Prince Lumbini in Nepal in his previous life. He was the youngest son of King Maharatha. He and his two elder brothers passed through the forest while hunting one day. They found a tigress with her cubs. She and her cubs could hardly move, weak from starvation.

Their pitiable situation scrutinized him. So, before he could reach his destination far away from the forest, Prince Mahasattva returned to the tiger and offered them his flesh and blood to save them.

Later, his two brothers returned to the same place, but they saw only his bones and hair. In his honor, the King and Queen buried a small casket covered with seven kinds of jewels, laid his bones, and built a stupa over the place, which became very popular among Buddhist and Hindu pilgrims.

The whole area is covered with sacred flags on the top of a small hill. However, the Namu Buddha tour is beautiful, quiet, and pure.

The environment is clean, with fresh, calm, and healthy natural air, which makes it the right place for meditation and practice. From the hill, you can see the beautiful sunrise and sunset. You can also visit the famous Thrangu Tashi Yangtse Monastery, where more than 250 monks reside today. Despite being close to the capital, this area still has a typical Nepali rural lifestyle.

The Namu Buddha tour starts at four and takes you through the valley by jeep or bus. The roads run through rice fields and remote villages off the beaten track. You can also trek from Banepa, passing through Panauti and Sankhu, to Namu Buddha.

While returning, you can also visit the imposing Shiva statue (43.5m high), considered the world's most enormous Shiva statue. Feel free to contact us for more details.

## **It's the best traveling season.**

March to June and September to December are the best touring seasons in Namu Buddha. We are not providing vehicles during the monsoon season because we cannot travel on gravel roads, and we are not suggesting you travel over either. Monsoons have heavy rainfalls and are too muddy along the route. It would help to be careful with a leash while traveling in [Nomo Buddha](#) during the monsoon season.
